



Measles Statement from the Camp Ma-He-Tu Board of Directors

Measles has been prevalent in Rockland County, New York where Camp Ma-He-Tu is located. We have received guidance from several sources and as such, our policy about vaccinations of campers, staff, and adult attendees against measles is as follows:

1. All children attending Camp Ma-He-Tu during 2nd, 3rd, and 4th encampments and the Women in the Woods session must have received two doses of the MMR vaccine.
2. All staff members working at Camp Ma-He-Tu at any time during the summer must have received two doses of the MMR vaccine.
3. Adults attending during the Women in the Woods session must adhere to the following guidelines regarding vaccination against measles.
 - a. If born before January 1, 1957, proof of vaccination is not needed
 - b. Those born after January 1, 1957 will need to provide the following:
 - i. Proof of vaccination or;
 - ii. Having a history of disease or;
 - iii. Serology proving immunity which is a simple blood test.

All immunizations must be recorded on the camper, staff, or Women in the Woods attendee health forms. Any attendee or staff member without the proper measles vaccinations will not be permitted to attend camp.
