Safety Rules for Women in the Woods

In the interest of safety, we thought it best to set some ground rules to help us in keeping track of your children. A most important rule is: an adult must supervise children under 16 years of age at ALL times. We ask that you personally check the child/children in with the counselor in charge of the activity at the beginning of the activity period, and meet that child at the end of the period. IF your child is NOT signed up for an activity, we insist that she be participating in an activity with you or with an adult you designate.

We suggest that you might "pool" your resources by asking another adult to help in overseeing that children are moving along to their selected activities, especially when coming up from the waterfront. We also ask that you go over the physical boundaries of the camp, and that children not cross these boundaries without adult supervision.

Since important announcements are usually made right before dismissal from the Dining Hall, please do not leave the meal early.

We don't mean to overburden you with the rules, but we want to ensure that we have a safe and fun-filled time at Women in the Woods.
